School Footpath



We have undertaken a review of the school timetable and are in the process of trialling some changes to the internal structure of the school day. Assemblies have been moved to 9am, playtimes and lunchtimes have been staggered in each Key Stage and lunchtimes have been reduced by 15 minutes. KS1 currently have break at 10.30am and lunch from 12-12.45pm. They also have an afternoon break as before. KS2 currently have break at 10.45am and lunch from 12.15-1.00pm. These changes have been made as part of our continuous drive to improve learning and the children's experience of school.
