Flu Vaccination

We have been asked to share some information from the NHS in respect of the Nasal Flu Programme which takes place tomorrow. Some parents are concerned that if their child develops a high temperature after having the vaccine, they will not know whether to isolate and book a test or not for Covid-19. We have been advised that the nasal spray flu vaccine can cause a mild fever which should respond to paracetamol. Therefore, the key thing is that a temperature following the vaccine will respond to paracetamol, whereas Covid-19 will not.

If you have missed the deadline to enrol your child for the vaccine tomorrow, we have attached information to enable you to book an appointment at a separate clinic.
