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Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you so much for your patience and understanding over the last 24 hours. Your messages have been kind, supportive and most welcome during this challenging time. I know how difficult it is for you to hear confusing messages with things changing every five minutes, but hopefully the dust will settle over the next few days and we will start to get back into a new routine. The office will continue to open Monday to Friday from 8:30 – 12pm and 1-3:30pm so if you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Thank you to everyone who completed their keyworker place applications so promptly. This information has been collated and bubble groupings organised so you should have received a letter confirming your place and all the arrangements. As things stand currently, we will have 108 children attending school in 8 bubbles.

For the children who will be remaining at home and accessing remote learning we will continue to use Class Dojo and Tapestry. Please see attached the home learning policy, shared in our previous lockdown which provides details of what to expect. Online learning will be available from tomorrow.

In order to ensure that children have everything they need at home to support with home learning we would like the children to have their current exercise books and some reading books. This will ensure that we have an ongoing record of the children's progress and will be very useful in assessing the children when they return to school. In order to facilitate this, we will be inviting you to come to school at a specified time tomorrow to collect the things you need for the children.

**In order to ensure everyone's safety when collecting resources, the following expectations are made:**

- Only one adult per child may come to school to collect books (children may accompany)
- Face coverings must be worn by all adults on the school site – including outdoors on the playground
- A minimum distance of 2m must be maintained between all adults including parents, staff and children, where people are not part of the same household
- All pedestrians must keep to the right on playgrounds / footpaths
- Books will be placed outside on a table by the teacher, you must wait until the teacher has stepped back from the table before approaching to collect the books to ensure a safe distance is maintained
- Where families have more than one child in the school, books will be collected from the collection point for your **youngest child** – all siblings books will be brought to one place by the staff
- If there is more than one person collecting at the same time, please form a queue ensuring a 2m distance between families
- Please do not keep the teacher talking for too long and leave the site as soon as you have your books

The collection times and points are as follows, please enter the site via the specified gate and go the collection point:
