#### Flu Vaccination

We have been asked to share some information from the NHS in respect of the Nasal Flu Programme which takes place in school next Thursday (12<sup>th</sup> November). Some parents are concerned that if their child develops a high temperature after having the vaccine, they will not know whether to isolate and book a test or not for Covid-19. We have been advised that the nasal spray flu vaccine can cause a mild fever which should respond to paracetamol. Therefore, the key thing is that a temperature following the vaccine will respond to paracetamol, whereas Covid will not.
