SCIENCE

In science, our topic this term will be forces and magnets and after the October half term we will be studying teeth and eating. This will give the children the opportunity to study the human digestive system which is always fascinating.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY

Throughout our topic children will have the opportunity to study different building methods from the Stone Age and Roman Eras. As well as this, children will continue to follow the food for life cooking program.

GEOGRAPHY / HISTORY

Our main history topic this term will be studying early British civilisation. This will include Stone Age and Roman periods. This will lead us to looking at how our country has changed over time and what early landmarks are still visible today.

CURRICULUM INFORMATION

AUTUMN TERM 2019

Years 3 and 4

ART

In art we will be studying different painting techniques from the Stone Age and how early man created different materials to use in dyeing clothes and painting on walls. We will also look at mo-saics and pottery during our Roman topic.



During the term, we will be having visits from the Dogs Trust to work with children around understanding dogs behaviour. As well as this we will be having a visit from UK Pro Halfpipe champion Mike Mullen.



MUSIC

In music, the classes will be following Music Express scheme of work, this will help children develop their rhythm, instrument knowledge and composing their own pieces of work.



COMPUTING

In computing this term we will be looking at developing touch typing skills and the use of basic Microsoft Office

packages including Word, PowerPoint and Publisher. Children will also use Times Table Rockstars to practice their times tables.

ENGLISH

In literacy, we will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation throughout our lessons. The children will be taught how to write effective stories, diary entries from the past, explanations about how things work, as

well as straight forward recounts and myths.
All our literacy work will be linked to the topics of study to encourage more creative writing.



In maths the children will continue to work on learning their times tables with the hope that by the end of Year 4 the children know all times tables up to 12×12 . By the end of Year 4 children will sit a new Government multi-

plication assessment. Maths will be taught in mixed 3/4 classes following our Mastery maths planning. Children will begin the term looking at place value and finish with multiplication and division.

RE

In RE children will be looking at early Christian beliefs and different people of faith, courage and commitment

PE

Our PE topics this term include orienteering skills (map work and using a compass) gymnastics, football and tennis. As well as PE curriculum children will continue to do the daily mile around our school field and skip to be fit a short intense skipping programme.



PSHE

PSHE this term is all about getting on and new beginnings. As well as looking at working together and anti bullying. E-safety will be taught alongside all computing lessons.
