



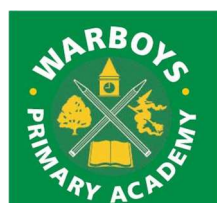

We have also taken the decision to put the following measures in place:

- School will be reducing access to visitors.
- If your child presents at school with a new continuous cough or high temperature, we will be asking you to collect them.
- If any member of your household is affected by the symptoms of Coronavirus (high temperature or new, continuous cough), your whole household must now self-isolate for 14 days. If you choose to self-isolate, we will support you in this decision and authorise the absence using a special absence code for this. Please continue to report all absences via the usual channels.
- If you choose to self-isolate the staff at the school will work with you to provide work to be completed at home to minimise the impact of missing essential learning.

Please be assured that in these uncertain times, all decisions made are in line with current Government guidance and always have the best interests of our children and our community at the heart of them. We will keep you up to date with information as we receive it.
