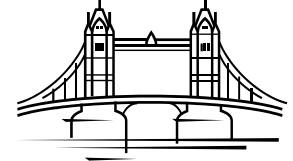
### Seasonal Changes:

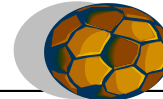
