We have said for those who do want to do some work or revision, to use their homework booklets to read through and remind themselves of key concepts and units taught.

Your support this weekend and next week will be really appreciated. Could you please:

- Ensure your child sticks to their normal sleeping routine as much as possible and rests.
- Encourage your child to drink plenty of water, stay hydrated and bring a bottle to school.
- Support your child to arrive in plenty of time to avoid any stress or anxiety that lateness can cause.

- Remind them to ask for help if they need it from an adult, and that some questions are meant to be challenging. These assessments are just as much a test of stamina and resilience than the curriculum content.
