Staying COVID-19 Secure – Summary

How are we making sure that our Academies are safe?



We will check for risks before opening.



We will enforce good personal hygiene and frequent handwashing.



Anyone unwell cannot come into the Academy.



We will have a robust cleaning regime that is more frequent.



There will be less children in a room together.



To achieve this, we will need to make reasonable changes to the Academy day.

What are the benefits to children coming into the Academy?



It is good for their mental health and wellbeing.



It is good for them to socialise with other children.



Being in an Academy is the best place for them to learn.

What if there is a case of COVID-19 in the Academy?



The person with the symptoms must self-isolate for 7-days.



The people they live with must also self-isolate for 14-days.



If anyone at the Academy tests positive for COVID-19, the whole class and other people who were in close proximity must self-isolate for 14-days.

What else might change?



The time you drop off and pick up your child.



Your child may not have all their full normal lessons.



Your child may have a different classroom and teacher.



We will change how we serve lunch.
