The assessments will take place in the morning and sessions are as follows:

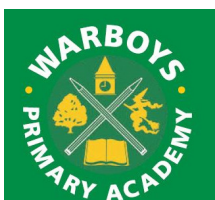
Monday 13 th May -	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar
